Prof. Marcelo Molina, has once again achieved a proud achievement by being selected as one of **Stanford-Elsevier's Top 2% Scientists** from all over the world, according to the ranking released on September 2024. This recognition is clear evidence of Prof. Molina's contribution to the academic world, which assess the impact throughout his academic career.

Stanford/Elsevier's Top 2% Scientist Rankings is a list of **the world's most influential scientists**, based on a composite indicator (c-score) calculated from Scopus data provided by Elsevier through the International Center for the Study of Research (ICSR) Lab. The c-score focuses on impact (citations) of publications using career-long data until the end of 2023 and it also incorporates information on co-authorship and author positions.

The ranking identifies scientists from 22 scientific fields and 174 subfields using standardized citation metrics, providing a snapshot of the world's most influential researchers.
